Truck Parking

As of 11/20/19



You are end of the train! Thank the drivers for their patience as they have gone through the registration and photo process. Remind them of the rules for the truck parking area. Point them in the direction of the indoor trucks and vendors where they can get the photo of their truck and other information for the week.

- Truck parking is on a first come first served basis. No spots are reserved.
- Trucks should be parked 8-10 feet apart with at least 20 foot aisles, whenever possible.
- Go with the direction of the parking lead. There are times when parking requirements need to change and they will be the one in the know.
- Make sure you are always wearing your safety vest. This will help ensure the drivers can see you, especially when backing into spots.
- If there are group of trucks from the same company/chapter/family, try to park them as a group. However, if they do not come through the line together do not hold spots for the missing vehicles.

Special notes: There are no pop-up tents allowed on the show field. Also, truck camping is prohibited. If drivers would like to sit out by their trucks, they will need to do so in between trucks and not in the aisles. There will be golf carts up and down the aisles.
